Submitted

I am serving as the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Chennai City-V, Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Alandur, Chennai-16. Based on the 3 petitions dated 06.11.2016 & 21.11.2016 from the complainant, Preliminary Enquiry was conducted and based upon the result of such Preliminary Enquiry this Regular Case is registered against the above noted accused.

The Following Allegations found in the petitions were taken up for the Preliminary Enquiry:-

- 1) A-1 amassed huge wealth by corrupt and fraudulent manner disproportionate to known source of income.
- 2) In 15% quota in NRI students' admission in Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University, Taramaini, AO-1 with the co ordination of AO-2 collected nearly 25 to 30 Lakhs per applicant and arranged false visa from foreign countries through his middle man in East Asian Countries. Most of the students are not NRI.

- 3) A-1 received enormous amount as illegal gratification by inducing the students who wants to stay abroad is permitted to stay away by forging the attendance in University as if attending the classes.
- 4) A-1 with the assistance of A-2 to 5, misappropriated building funds and other construction and made expenditure beyond sealing limit.
- 5) A-1 with the assistance A-2 to 5, for the appointment of 30 Assistant Professor and 30 appointments in non law subjects planned to collect Rs.20 to 30 lakhs for each post by stating that the amount is to be paid to the Garden as well as to the Hon'ble Law Minister.
- 6) Huge amount have been realized by A-1,3,4 and A-6 one Tr.Rajesh in paper chasing and in examination by passing failed candidates and un qualified examiners have also been utilized for this purpose.
- 7) Huge amount were diverted and paid for esthetic wood work, beautification, landscaping, furniture, large number of Computers and un wanted books for the university by A-1 with the assistance of AO-2 to 5 without obtaining prior sanction of Finance Committee, Purchase committee, Senate and Syndicate.

During the Preliminary Enquiry, suspicion of commission of cognizable offence appeared in the allegation-2 and hence this information is registered forthwith without delay leaving the other allegations for investigation after registration of this case.

- A1. Dr.P.Vanangamudi, M/61, S/o K.C.Palanichamy, Former Vice Chancellor, Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University, Chennai-28 was a Public Servant during the relevant period of allegation.
- A2. Dr.K.S.Sarwani, F/51, D/o K.Suryanarayana, Professor and HOD, Department of Inter Disciplinary Studies and Director, Department of Distance Education. Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University, Perungudi campus, Chennai-113 was a Public Servant during the relevant period of allegation.
- A3. Tr.V.Balaji, M/47, S/o. K.Venugopal Raju, in charge Registrar, the Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University, Chennai-28 was a Public Servant during the relevant period of allegation.
- A4. Dr.S.K.Ashok Kumar, M/41, S/o S.K.Loganathan, Dy. Registrar in charge, the Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University, Chennai-28 was a Public Servant during the relevant period of allegation.
- A5. Tr.D.Jaisankar M/51, S/o Late.C.Duraisamy, Associate Professor, Department of Inter Disciplinary Studies, Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University and Deputy Registrar, (i/c) Finance, Chennai-28 was a Public Servant during the relevant period of allegation.
- A6. Tr.K.Rajesh M/39, S/o R.Kannan, Administrative Officer, O/o the Controller of Examination, Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University, Chennai-28 was a Public Servant during the relevant period of allegation.

Pertaining to allegation-2, the enquiry reveals as follows:

During the Enquiry it was ascertained that, rules and procedures were violated and floated in respect of admissions in NRI quota during the tenure of A-1 as Vice Chancellor, and in particular during the academic year 2016-2017, out of 93 students

admitted in NRI quota, only 18 applications were in order, remaining 75 applications, several certificates and documents which are essentially required to be enclosed along with the application for admission under NRI quota have not been enclosed. Likewise, one Tr. Vivek Jayaraman, S/o V. Jayaraman, 31/1, Mannai Nagar, Thiruvarur was admitted under NRI quota without certificates which are mandatory for admission. Though the A-1, Dr.P.Vanangamudi was retired on Superannuation on 31.10.2016, the Registrar i/c A-3 Dr.V.Balaji who is sub ordinate to A-1 issued Re vide Proceedings No.5220/Regr/Estt[T]/A2/2016 employment to A-1 his Dt.15.10.2016 till the end of academic year i.e., up to 30.06.2017 by wrongly quoting the Proviso VIII (1) in chapter IX of the Statutes of the Law University which is applicable only for teaching staff and both abused their official position.

Out of total number of seats 15 % has been earmarked for NRI. There are 3 categories in NRI admissions.

Category-I–NRI parent: The NRI should be a Parent (Father or Mother)

Category-II–NRI Guardian: If the candidate has no Parent where he has been taken as a ward by a near relative or someone and such NRI Guardian has been legally declared as the Guardian of the candidate by the court as per the provision of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890.

Category-III-NRI Sponsor: the sponsor under this category has to submit a certificate indicating the relationship with the candidate so sponsored. If sufficient number of NRI candidates are not available under category I or II, then category III candidates shall be considered for admissions.

The candidates must furnish photo copies of the following documents along with the filled application:

- 1) NRI status certificate issued by the Indian Embassy of the respective country with seal.
- 2) Copy of the NRE (Non Resident External) or NRO Bank Account Pass Book of the NRI.
- 3) Copy of the valid passport of the NRI.
- 4) Certificate of Relationship (between the NRI and the candidate issued by the competent Authority).
- 5) Employment Certificate of the NRI [In case of self employment, nature of the business, annual income and required proof of Income Tax payment (for the last 3 years)
- 6) Qualifying Mark / Grade list of the candidate.
- 7) Certificate showing that the candidate has proficiency in English Language.
- 8) School/College Transfer Certificate or (Migration certificate wherever necessary)
- 9) Eligibility Certificate: Candidates with qualifying degree from Deemed University/DDE of Tamil Nadu state Universities should obtain an Eligibility Certificate by submitting an Indian Bank Challan in the prescribed form for a sum of Rs.500/- whereas Rs.600/- for the other state Universities along with a requisition letter to the Registrar.

- 10) Joint Declaration by the parent and student (Annexure X in the prospectus)
- 11) Affidavit by the student (Annexure XI) and parent/Guardian in 20/- Rupees stamp paper (Annexure XII in prospectus).

But, on perusal of the enclosures with the application submitted by the NRI in respect of admission of one Tr.Vivek Jayaraman under category III – NRI sponsor in 3 year LL.B (Hons) course vide Provisional Admission No.959/Regr/Law Admns/2015 Dt.19.10.2015 the following essential copies of the documents were not available.

- 1) NRI status certificate issued by the Indian Embassy of the respective country with seal.
- 2) Copy of the NRE (Non Resident External) or NRO Bank Account Pass Book of the NRI.
- 3) Certificate of Relationship (between the NRI and the candidate issued by the competent Authority).
- 4) Eligibility Certificate: Candidates with qualifying degree from Deemed University/DDE of Tamil Nadu state Universities should obtain an Eligibility Certificate by submitting an Indian Bank challan in the prescribed form for a sum of Rs.500/- whereas Rs.600/- for the other state Universities along with a requisition letter to the Registrar.
- 5) Joint Declaration by the parent and student (Annexure X in the prospectus Doc.4)
- 6) Affidavit by the student (Annexure XI) and parent/Guardian in 20/- Rupees stamp paper (Annexure XII in prospectus)

The A-3 also during the course of enquiry admitted that, the above documents were not available with the application. As per Section 6 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 the status of a person as a resident or non-resident (NRI) depends on his period of stay in India. The period of stay is counted in number of days for each financial year beginning from 1st April to 31st March. An individual will be treated as a resident in India in any previous year (April to March) if he/she is in India for at least 182 days in that year or at least 365 days during 4 years presiding that year and at least 60 days in that year. An individual who does not satisfy both the conditions as mentioned above will be treated as non-resident in the previous year. The 2nd condition i.e. 365 days is relaxed for an Indian Citizen who leaves India in any year for the purpose of employment out-side India or as a crew member of an Indian ship and an Indian Citizen or a person of Indian Origin who resides out-side India and who comes on a visit to India. That a person shall be deemed to be a Indian Origin if he or either of his parents or any of his grandparents, was born in undivided India.

During the tenure of A-1 as Vice Chancellor, the rules and procedures for the admissions under NRI quota were floated and violated, and admissions were made without essential certificates and Documents. This may be due to pecuniary advantages. For law admissions during the academic year 2013 - 2014, A-1 is the one of the co-ordinator. In the year 2014–2015, A-3, A-4 were Chief Co-ordinators & A-2 & A-5 were one of the Coordinators. In the Year 2015 -2016, A-2, A-3 & A-4 were one of the Co-ordinator.

Re - employment was given to A-1 former Vice Chancellor Dr.P.Vanangamudi as Professor after his retirement, violating the rules and procedures.

Hence, from the enquiry it appears that the accused conspired together, forged the documents as though the students were NRI and cheated the University and by abusing their office as Public Servants and while holding their office as Public Servants at the campus of Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University, Chennai-28 during April 2014 and 2015, obtained the pecuniary advantage.

Hence, as there is prima facie on the complaint and a reasonable suspicion for the commission of cognizable offence, I register a case in Vigilance and Anti Corruption, Chennai City-V Detachment, Cr.No.01/AC/2018 U/s 120-B, 420, 468 IPC and u/s 13 (2) r/w 13 (1) (d) PC Act 1988 against the accused today on 22.03.2018 at 16.00 hours.
